

Emergency Shelter Operations & Services

- 1. Decatur Cooperative Ministry, Inc. \$50,000** – Decatur Cooperative Ministry Hagar’s House provides emergency shelter for homeless families and services to homeless and at-risk families who are DeKalb County homeless residents.
- 2. Rebecca’s Tent - \$20,000** – The Women seasonal shelter provides emergency shelter for homeless women and other services to homeless and at-risk unsheltered women in DeKalb County.
- 3. The Salvation Army Red Shield \$90,000** – The Salvation Army Red Shield Shelter provides emergency housing and 30-day assessment beds to include 5 family housing units, 2 beds for single women and 2 beds for single men who are DeKalb County homeless residents.
- 4. St. Vincent de Paul of Georgia \$20,000** – This Prevention Program provides financial assistance to DeKalb residents in imminent danger of homelessness or loss of utilities. They will provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized. The funds under this program are intended to target individuals and families who would be homeless but for this assistance.
- 5. Yes 4 Youth \$15,000** – This Prevention Program provides homeless youth financial assistance to DeKalb residents in imminent danger of becoming homeless or loss of utilities. They will provide financial assistance and other services to prevent youth from becoming homeless and help those youth who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized. The funds under this program are intended to target youth who would be homeless but for this assistance.
